- S. 797, A bill to amend the Indian Law Enforcement Reform Act, the Indian Tribal Justice Act, the Indian Tribal Justice Technical and Legal Assistance Act of 2000, and the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to improve the prosecution of, and response to, crimes in Indian country, and for other purposes.
- S. 313, A bill to resolve water rights claims of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in the State of Arizona, and for other purposes.
- S. 375, A bill to authorize the Crow Tribe of Indians water rights settlement, and for other purposes.
- S. 965, A bill to approve the Taos Pueblo Indian Water Rights Settlement Agreement, and for other purposes.
- S. 1105, A bill to authorize the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Commissioner of Reclamation, to develop water infrastructure in the Rio Grande Basin, and to approve the settlement of the water rights claims of the Pueblos of Nambe, Pojoaque, San Ildefonso, and Tesuque.
- S. 1388, A bill to provide for equitable compensation to the Spokane Tribe of Indians of the Spokane Reservation for the use of tribal land for the production of hydropower by the Grand Coulee Dam, and for other purposes.
